IOM is committed to a diverse and inclusive environment. External candidates will be considered for this vacancy. This is a request for Curricula / **Consultant District Health Information System (DHIS)**. The success candidate will be offered Consultancy Contract. *Applications from qualified female candidates are encouraged.*

1. Nature of the consultancy:

The consultant will work with the Building Healthy Cities (BHC) team in Makassar, Indonesia to support on interoperability of data especially health data. A consultant will support District Health Information System (DHIS 2) implementation in Makassar, Indonesia.

2. IOM Project to which the Consultancy is contributing:

The Project "Building Healthy Cities" (BHC) aims to embed a health equity lens into existing Smart Cities in India, Indonesia, and Vietnam, and improve data flow by focusing on city policies, planning, and services. Despite being outside of the health sector, decisions about environment, transport, sanitation, recreation, information and communication technology (ICT) infrastructure and the built environment can have a large impact on health. By complementing Smart Cities, BHC aims to improve access to health services, increase availability of usable data for urban health decision making, and decrease lifestyle and environmental risk factors for poor nutrition and noncommunicable diseases. In Indonesia, BHC is partnering with Smart City initiatives in Makassar, South Sulawesi, a city which experiences urbanization and its subsequent issues. The project will empower citizens, health professionals and policymakers to use data to improve the health of Makassar.

The project will lead to increased partnership between sectors and with health actors in the private sector, funding for healthy lifestyle related projects, increased demand for healthy city environments amongst under-represented populations, data access and use amongst decision makers and citizens, and knowledge transfer for eventual scale-up in other Smart Cities.

Currently, Makassar have implemented interoperability of data through District Health Information System version 2 (DHIS 2). BHC will support on interoperability of data especially health data in each partner city. To support DHIS 2 implementation in Makassar, we are seeking a consultant to Implement DHIS 2 in Makassar, Indonesia. This consultancy are meant to provide us a service to technically support DHIS implementation in Makassar.

The consultant will be working under the direct supervision and management of the NMHO in Makassar and overall supervision of Programme Coordinator Eastern Region in Makassar, and in closed coordination with Senior Migration Health Adviser (SMHA) in Jakarta.

3. Tasks to be performed under this contract:

1. Facilitate district health information system (DHIS) data management
2. Support health workforce on DHIS 2 implementation.
3. Facilitate enhancement of DHIS 2 that will be implemented in Makassar
4. In coordination with Pusdatin and Center of excellent (from University) facilitate online self-assessment and training on general data management and basic knowledge of DHIS 2 in Makassar.
5. Review and analyze activity result on DHIS 2 training in Makassar.
6. In coordination with Pusdatin develop platform on healthy city program and integrate into DHIS 2.
7. Coordinate the implementation plan on DHIS 2 in Makassar.
8. Coordinate and facilitate DHIS 2 training in Makassar.
9. Facilitate module/guideline development on DHIS 2 as needed.
10. monitoring and supervision on DHIS 2 implementation in primary health care (Puskesmas).

4. Tangible and measurable outputs:

The consultant will provide the following outputs:

- a) Online training for data management and DHIS 2
- b) Platform on healthy city program and integrate into DHIS 2.
- c) Activity report on DHIS training and implementation
- d) Module/guideline as needed

The National Migration Health Officer (NMHO) will review and evaluate these outputs and give approval on the satisfactory performance of the consultant.

5. Realistic Delivery Schedule

The consultant will conduct the above activities for MHU throughout the consultancy of 3 months period.

The Consultant will determine his/her final work schedule at the beginning of the assignment with the approval of NMHO. The work schedule will set up clear deadlines for the completion of each expected deliverables

6. Remuneration and Terms of Payment

The Consultant will receive an all-inclusive consultancy fee which will be paid to the bank account indicated by the Consultant. Payment shall be made based on the output delivered and satisfactory work completion as approved by IOM.

- The first instalment in the amount of 30% of the consultancy fee shall be paid upon submission of approved activity report period month 1
- The second instalment in the amount of 30% of the consultancy fee shall be paid upon submission of approved activity report period month 2
- The third instalment in the amount of 40% of the total fee shall be paid upon submission final activities report and approval by Program Coordinator and Project Manager

If necessary, all duty travel and duty travel accommodation arrangements will be taken care of by IOM and IOM will cover separately all travel and per diem costs incurred by the Consultant during his/her assignment.

7. Performance indicators for evaluation of results (value of services rendered in relation to their cost).

The quality, targeted and detailed of the work performed as established in above as well as compliance with agreed delivery dates.

8. Work Place

The Consultant's place of duty is Makassar and will undertake duty travel as needed.

IOM will assist the Consultant in:

- Sharing any existing IOM project materials relevant to the subject matter;
- Arranging field visits as requested, if necessary, by the manager;

9. Qualifications or Specialized Knowledge/Experience required:

The Consultant should have :

- Completed a minimum Bachelor degree (or equivalent advanced university degree) specializing in Public Health (preferably on Health information system), Urban Planning, Informatic Management, Health Data Management, or Statistics;
- At least 3 years experience on Health Information system
- Experience in data production of health and Smart City-related sector data systems
- Demonstrated track record in e-Government and/or sector specific (health, etc.) databases, strategies, frameworks, or policies especially relating to privacy, data storage, data standards, data dissemination, etc.
- Demonstrated ability for system analysis on health information system.
- Good written and spoken communication and negotiation skills
- Thorough understanding of data driven and smart cities initiatives or a desire to acquire such understanding.

Language: Fluency in English is required. Knowledge of Bahasa Indonesia considered an asset.
